## Your Child's Morrisby Profile and Careers Next Steps Support Meeting

In November 2024, your child will decide on the A level courses they wish to take – which should be linked to their future career options and Post 18 plans such as university or higher level apprenticeships.

Having a clear destination driven focus will be critical to the decision making and we are now offering a follow up Next Steps Careers Support meeting to all Year 10 students from April to July 2024. This is a key element of our careers programme and follows on from the work the students have carried out exploring careers in the Morrisby Careers Platform. The advice is impartial and always in the best interests in supporting their next steps and future career goals.

We encourage you to look at your child's Morrisby Aptitudes Profile which shows their strengths in Verbal, Numerical, Abstract, Spatial and Mechanical assessments. You might also find their Work Style, Personality and Learning style interesting. A Careers Advisor from Morrisby will meet with your child **virtually** or Mrs Walker our Careers Leader will meet your child face to face. The outcome of the meeting will be saved in your child's Morrisby Profile. You can request that your child gives you access to their Morrisby account with Parental Permission towards the bottom of their Morrisby homepage.

In terms of preparation before the interview, can you please ensure that you child does the following:

- 1. Goes to their LOCKER in their Morrisby Profile
- 2. Clicks into the Careers Interview and Meetings section
- 3. Clicks on the Background Tab and completes the questions and presses SAVE
- 4. Clicks on the Review Tab and completes the questions and presses SAVE

Your child's meeting will be held in the Careers Office (at the back of the 6<sup>th</sup> Form Centre) and will take place in the school day between Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> April and Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July starting with form 10 Brunel.
